Superior PVC pipe systems that outlast and outperform flexible tube.

While other companies use inferior flexible polyethylene tube, we install only commercial-grade rigid PVC pipe systems. PVC delivers long-lasting, low-maintenance performance that polyethylene tube just can't match.

- **Greater durability.** Our rigid PVC systems have a burst strength of 200 PSI compared to 80 PSI for polyethylene tube.
- **Stronger connections.** Our seals are welded and glued to provide a sealed system, unlike the leak prone clamped joints of a tube system.
- **Longer lasting.** Our rigid PVC systems last 50+ years while tube systems typically start to deteriorate within 5-10 years.
- **More reliable installation.** Rigid PVC installs straight and stays straight while polyethylene tube starts as a roll and can roll up and twist out of position displacing the heads.
- **Greater efficiency.** Our systems have lower friction loss allowing larger systems to be installed without a booster pump.

Many other lawn sprinkler companies are not licensed in plumbing or CCCDI (Cross-Connection Control Device Inspector). They are also at the scheduling mercy of the plumbing company they hire to complete the connection and required certification of your system.

DRF has all three licenses — plumbing, CCCDI and irrigation — in house. Our technicians are knowledgeable about important factors such as water source and pressure, soil type, planting materials, and weather conditions, and will design your system based on your property's unique characteristics. Plus, we have 25 years of experience in the plumbing and sprinkler system business.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. *What will my sprinkler system consist of?*

A. Although every system is tailored to meet individual needs, a typical system is comprised of a controller (which functions as the brains of the system), valves (which open and close to release and stop the flow of water to underground pipes) and sprinklers (which actually distribute the water to a given area).

It's best if the same company manufactures all components of a system in order to ensure that they are designed to work well together. Most manufacturers make only one or two components of the complete system. However, DRF uses only components made by Hunter, who designs and makes all of the parts of a complete irrigation system.

Q. *Will the installation damage my existing landscaping?*

A. It's impossible to install a lawn sprinkler system and leave absolutely no evidence of the process. However, with our state of the art equipment and highly trained technicians, we minimize any evidence of the installation. In most cases it is difficult to tell we were even there, and any visible signs are completely gone within two weeks of completion.



Q. *How long will you be working on my property?*

A. Most residential systems are completed in two full working days. We are able to work this efficiently because we hold all licenses and can send the right people at the right time to get the job completed on schedule.



Q. *Will my automatic sprinkler system water as well as I can water by hand?*

A. It will do a much better job, because a professionally designed system will deliver exactly the right amount of water to individual lawn and landscaped areas.

Q. *Will my automatic sprinkler system use more water than I'm currently using?*

A. No. You will use less water with a professionally installed automatic system compared to regular watering with garden hoses. Our soldered and glued connections will insure optimal application rates and eliminate wasted water leaking out of the system underground. You'll never have to worry about runoff from over watering or wasting water when you forget to turn off the hose. And with a Hunter rain sensor, your system will know when it is raining and simply shut itself off when water is not needed.

Some of these include automatic fertilizer/pesticide systems, buried detachable HosEnclose systems, wireless remote control units and more.
